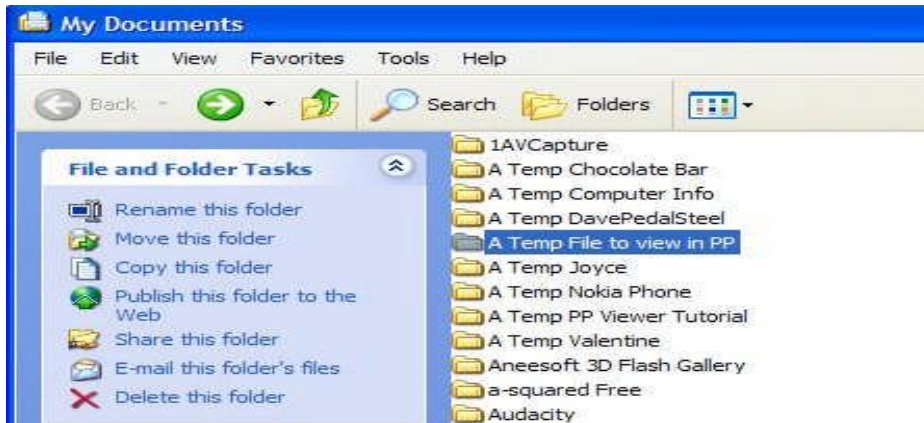

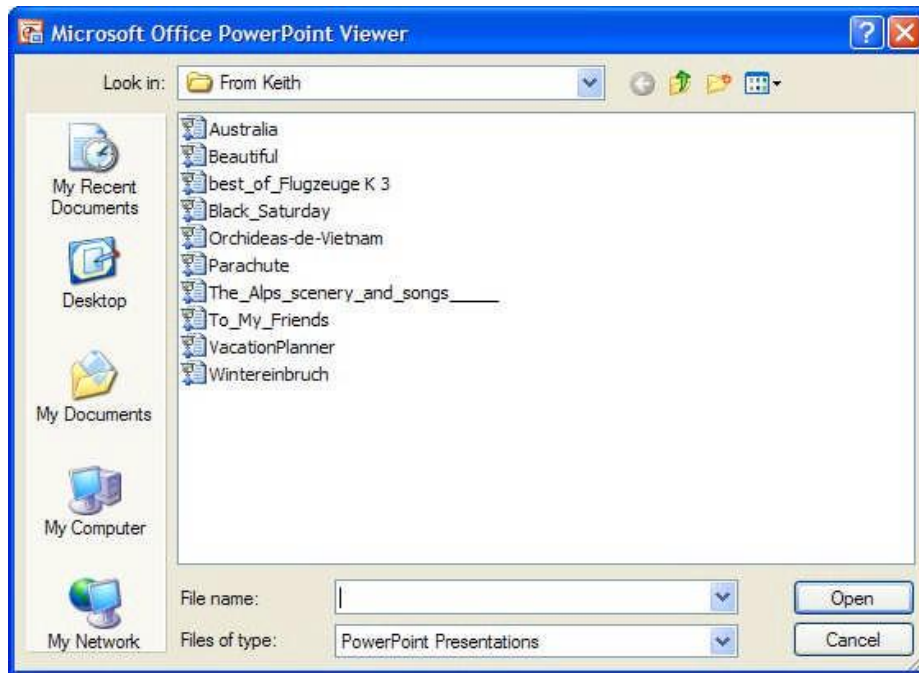
Once you have PP PROGRAM downloaded go to and click on:

- START
- ALL PROGRAMS
- FIND THE PROGRAM: MICROSOFT OFFICE POWER POINT VIEWER 2003
- CLICK ON THE FILE TO OPEN THE VIEWER..(The PP screen just flashes for a sec and then opens the folder where your PPs are saved)
- IT SHOULD AUTOMATICALLY FIND YOUR FOLDER WITH YOUR POWER POINT PRESENTATIONS...
- IF NOT, then LOCATE THEM by CLICKING ON THE DOWN ARROW)

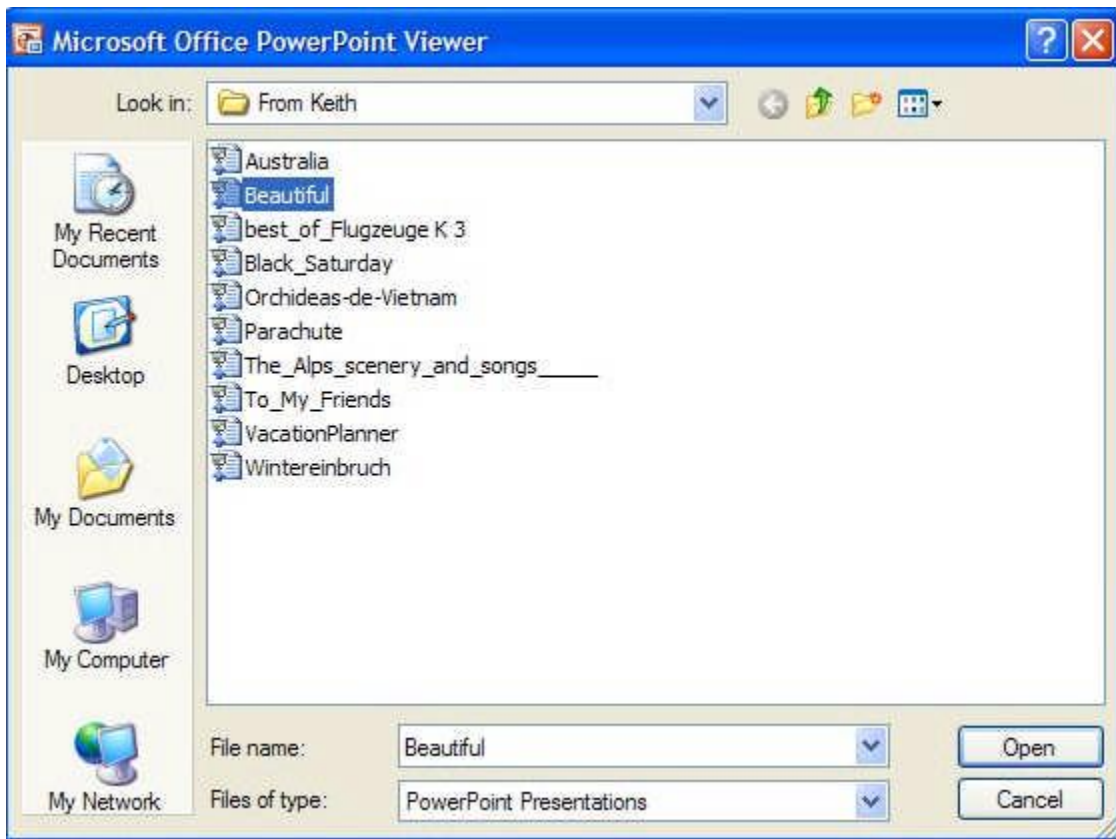


- As you can see above, I save my PP's in a Temp folder first. Then when I have time I will open them with the viewer and watch them. Some I save to a new file (PowerPoint Presentations), and some I delete after viewing.

Open your Folder (A temp File to view in PP) and view your PP's



- **FIND THE PP SHOW YOU WANT TO VIEW... DOUBLE CLICK ON IT AND THE SHOW WILL START RIGHT AWAY....**



- ***NOTE: SOME PP'S WILL GO FROM PAGE TO PAGE AUTOMATICALLY..BUT.. SOME YOU HAVE TO HIT THE ENTER KEY TO GO FROM PAGE TO PAGE***
- ***IF YOU WANT TO STOP THE PP BEFORE IT IS DONE, or EXIT IT AFTER WATCHING IT... HIT THE ESCAPE KEY...***

Can't View your Microsoft PP Presentation... Maybe it is your File Association Settings

CLICK ON:

- START

- CONTROL PANEL
- TOOLS (Top Menu Bar on Left hand side)
- FOLDER OPTIONS
- FILE TYPES
- Scroll down to PPT (or PPS) : PPT means MICROSOFT POWERPOINT PRESENTATION
: PPS means MICROSOFT POWERPOINT SLIDE SHOW
- If the description is blank then **CLICK** on **“NEW”** Type in the file Ext (in this case PPT or PPS)
- **CLICK** “Okay” and “Okay” until done

If there is a description and it is the wrong one you can change it by doing the following:

- Under where it says DETAILS FOR “PPT” (or “PPS”) EXTENSION
- **CLICK** on: **“CHANGE”**
- Choose the program you want to use to **“OPEN”** your presentations with and then
- **CLICK** “Okay” , “Okay” until done

It should work now. ... Hopefully...lol...
